Dear Families,

Due to the state's budget cuts, the District's summer school program has been severely impacted. We can only offer a limited program and have had to *eliminate* elementary and middle school summer school. The limited summer school programs being offered this summer include:

1. **7th Grade Algebra Academy** for eligible students participating in the GEAR Up grant program
2. **8th grade Summer Bridge Program** for eligible students who meet program criteria (failed math or English, score Far Below Basic/Below Basic on the STAR test) **9-12 grade**
3. **9-12 grade Credit Recovery Program**, to provide our high school students to opportunity to make up failed courses in order to better prepare them graduate from high school.
4. **Special Education Extended Year Program**, if this service is included in the student's Individual Education Plan.
5. **Summer Music Program** for students interested in continuing their music experience (This is a fee-based program.)

In spite of these severe reductions to the summer school program, **it is very important that our students continue to exercise their minds and bodies during the summer months.**

Reading daily for a minimum of 20 minutes is something everyone should do. If possible, it would be good for students to participate in any program that will exercise and stimulate their minds.
